One "memorial" dedicated to the master/person, Carlo Henke who has given a new dimension to the world of the martial arts: "working together wuth hulimity and dedition" at the international and national karate.

The athletes will be ranked for ages depending on the day/month and year of birth A Junior athletes can compete in the senior category

INDIVIDUAL KATA

Competition will take place with the division of participants according to their style, that are the following: SHOTOKAN (including Shotokai, Fudokan, etc.) SHITO RYU (which also includes Sankukai, different area school, etc.); GOJU RYU (which includes area and derivate school) WADO RYU (which also includes SHORIN RYU different area school).

All participants, besides the style and above-mentioned classes of age, will be also divided into male and female categories and will compete into the following grade categories:

The KATA choice is free, but in each match the athletes must perform a different KATA (participants up to orange belt are the only ones allowed to repeat the same KATA in more than one match). In the eventuality of a play-off the athletes must perform a different kata from the previous ones.

INDIVIDUAL KUMITE

All participants must be equipped with their own regulation safeties (according to the competition rules that they have chosen).

Competition will take place with two different referees' rules: SPORTS (**Shobu Sanbon**, and for youth classes as scheduled, **Shobu Nihon**) and TRADITIONAL (**Shobu Ippon**).

Shobu Sanbon and Shobu Ippon are two different competitions and athletes can freely choose one or the other one; or both. The choice of rules must be specified in your registration form.

The duration of the competition of the Shobu Nihon is one minute and half, whereas that one of Shobu Sanbon and Ippon is two minutes.

All participants will compete divided into the below classes of age, without grade subdivision (the minimum grade for participating in the traditional kumite competition Shobu Ippon is the brown belt) with the following weight categories:

Participants in the Shobu Nihon competition in class Children C will be divided into two level groups: a) up to green belt; b) blue-brown-black belts.

In class Children D, however, always in two groups: a) up to the blue belt; b) black-brown belts.

All participants in **Shobu Nihon** must be equipped with their own regulation safeties, included helmets and body protector.

Kumite weigh-in: all participants in individual Kumite competitions must be present one hour before the begining of their competion, because of the weight control (a tolerance of 500 gr. from the limit of their category is allowed for both males and females) which will take place "by sample".

Coach: only one coach for each club can enter in the competition area. He has to wear the federal uniform and gym shoes (in the absence of those requirements the coach will have to leave the area)

TEAM KATA

The team Kata competition is all stile. The team kata composed by 3 athletes.

The team Kata will compete divided between male and female, in the following categories:

- a) Absolutes (athletes from 18 to 51 years, all belts)
- b) Cadets (athletes from 14 to 17 years, all belts)
- c) Youth (athletes from 10 to 13 years, all belts)
- d) Children (composed of athletes till 9 years, every levels, also mixed female/male)

TEAM KUMITE (Sanbon e Ippon)

The team (without weight categories) will be composed by 3 athletes and one reserve, which can be used to replace an injured athlete, or upon request of the coach. However, the replacement can be done only in the following round.

At the beginning only 3 team athletes, without the reserve, will line up in the area of competition. A team with only 2 athletes at the beginning will not be allowed to compete and will be declared loser (kiken).

If during the shift, one of the members of the team members is injured and the doctor notice him/her unfit to continue the match the team can continue the match with only two athletes.

The team Kumite competition female and male, in the following categories:

- a) Absolutes (composed by athletes from 18 years) Shobu Sanbon and Shobu Ippon
- b) CADETS (composed by athletes from 14 to 17 years) Only Shobu Sanbon

GENERAL RULES

- 1) All competitors, under the President's responsibility of their club/association, must have regular sanitary certifications according to the laws in force in their own Country and they must be covered by their own insurance. On request the athletes must show a valid I.D. document and the federal membership card (certifying the grade owned).
- 2) If during the competitions some categories will have a poor number of athletes registered (less than four) the Organizing Committee will unquestionably arrange the passage of these athletes to the closer category.
- 3) Seen the nature of this event no claim will be accepted. Possible pertaining appeals must be immediately made in writing to the Chief Referees, paying the fee of Euro 50,00 (that will be returned if the appeal will be upheld).
- 4) The organizing committee declines all responsibilities for any accident in which people or things may incur before, during and after the event.
- 5) When the Sports Clubs register their athletes, they take upon themselves the responsibility that their own athletes are in conformity to the health certificates and everything provided in the present regulations.

GRAND CHAMPION "Memorial Carlo Henke"



At the end of the Kata individual competition (Saturday 2 November) and of the individual kumite Shobu Sanbon / Kumite Shobu Ippon (Sunday 3 November), there will be the competition named "Grand Champion" to crown the best champion in both specialities.

Are admitted in this competition, the top two classified in kata (black belt every style) and in Kumite Sanbon (every weight) Juniores and Seniores, and in Kumite Ippon the first three.

Athletes, will be divided into male and female, juniores and seniores will compete together without subdivision of style in Kata and without subdivision of weight in Kumite.

The board will be prepared at place on the basis of the present athletes and entitled as said below, it is not necessary to send in

advance the registration.

The participation in this competition is free.

Writing a presentation about Carlo Henke without falling into rhetoric is very difficult. We do not want to make the story of a man who, in the martial arts, made history.

His father Bruno was a major in the German army during the First World War and his mother Margherita had Polish origins. Raised in the determination of an iron education, a comfortable life but certainly not inclined to idleness.

One day he told that he would like to do the military academy. Perhaps it was not properly indicated to a man, who despite having discipline and order as points of reference, possessed a much more liberal spirit than one might have thought.

He devoted himself to various sports, from soccer to boxing, and in 1966, the year of the birth of his son Sean, he began the practice of Karate. The beatings, in those days, didn't seem to be very different from boxing-

In 1969 a serious accident brought him near to death for the first time.

He has always had esteem and gratitude for Master Hiroshi Shirai, born in 1937, his main teacher, who has always treated with adequate deference but without ever suffering particular psychological subjection.

He had a strong charisma both on the tatami and on the outside and he was able to identify and bring out the qualities of a person.

The federation he had created, Fesik, put it all before him, and those close to him, from Rita Merati, widow Henke, to Demetrio Donati, jokingly called "his third child". He was generous with those who showed commitment and fidelity but strict with those who entered the federation to enforce their own interests only-.

Karate and politics absorbed him almost completely and in his spare time he was devoted to reading. His speeches were never long and long-winded but always immediate and direct. And perhaps it was this way of presenting oneself simple and sincere that allowed it to achieve certain results and to be appreciated and esteemed by many people.

Carlo Henke has certainly supported his existence through noble sentiments and extraordinary sensitivity, followed ideals with obstinacy and coherence, created structures with intelligence and imagination, conducted actions with constancy and personality, maintained moderate and cordial behaviour, achieved goals in the absolute respect of people and events.

AWARDS CEREMONY

The first three classified athletes of each category and each competition will be awarded by medal and certificate. All participants will receive a gadget of attendance

The first four Clubs classified in the Kata (with separate rankings for each style), as well as the first four Clubs classified in Kumite (with separate rankings between Shobu Nihon, Shobu Sanbon and Shobu Ippon) will be awarded with prestigious trophies. Furthermore, at the end of all the competitions will be awarded the first three Clubs in absolute (which will take into account the scores of both kata and kumite in the various specialties). REGISTRATIONS

The deadline is the no later than October 20, 2019 - not later- on our site www.federkarate.net or by mail to segreteria@federkarate.it. The registration fee is € 25.00 per athlete and per speciality and € 50,00 for each team. It's clear that if competitors will be registered and they will be absent, registration fees will not be given back.

All the registration fees will be paid directly at the sport hall (ONLY BY CASH) at your arrival before competitions start. We inform you also that the absent athletes cannot be refunded).

ARBITRATION

Really because this event would be an unifying moment, independent from the Federal name of belonging. The participants Club/organizations could participate also with their referees.

These will have to send their availability (indicating the qualification possessed and email address) at the time of registration to the competit

Before the beginning of the competitions there will be as usual the arbitration meeting.
